Who Can Apply:

- High school seniors, college students renewing a previous Franklin County Cattlemen's Scholarship, or trade school students
- Must be a Franklin County, WA resident
- Must be planning a career in the Agricultural Industry (examples: veterinary medicine, education, agri-business, farming, ranching, rangeland management, physical/equine therapy, agricultural law, or other ag-supporting industries)
- Renewal applicants may request 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year Continuing Education Scholarships may not exceed 2x.

Scholarship Amounts:

- \$3,500 – \$1,000 (varies based on number of applicants)
- **Cindy Lancaster Scholarship:** \$1,000, for students pursuing an educational degree
